KEY RESPONSIBILITY

The successful candidate will:

- Program Oversight: Contribute to the leadership and success of MICN public health programs, and community health outreach events.
- Maintaining project documentation, monitoring data and all regulatory requirements, and scheduling and participating in monthly/weekly project meetings.
- Research and Scholarship: Demonstrate research excellence, including grant writing, program planning, and implementation. Also, develop and sustain a research program that results in high-quality publications, presentations, and efforts to secure grant funding.

- Service and Collaboration: Actively engage in international organizations, maternal and child health organizations, community, and university service while fostering interdisciplinary collaboration and advancing public health initiatives.
- Overseeing data collection and cleaning, uploading of data into a database, and data transfer.
- Assure policies and procedures for the MICN program are established with the input of the Co-directed Administrative Oversight team and align with state policies.
- Show evidence of effective service to community health and the public health profession.
- Have a strong commitment to advancing equity and diversity in maternal and child health
- Exhibiting the ability to navigate administrative processes, problem-solve, and implement programmatic initiatives effectively is highly desirable.
- Plan, implement and evaluate community-based research studies.
- Plan and administer program benchmarks, budgets and submit progress reports in a timely fashion.
- Assure access to quality maternal and child health care services to mothers and children, especially those with low incomes or limited availability of care.
- Develop program policies, logic models, flowcharts, and research or best practices related to MCH services.
- Increase regular screenings and follow-up diagnostic and treatment services for children and mothers who are low income and reside in rural areas.
- Provide access to preventive and primary care services for children who are low income and rehabilitative services for children with special health needs.
